Qualifications

- Prior training or experience required: Familiarity with archery and range safety
- Recommended: Archery Instructor Certified
- Current background check on file
- Must be physically independent to perform the duties of the volunteer position without the routine assistance of the medical professionals on site
- Flu Vaccine required November 1 - April 1
- Age 19+

Responsibilities

- **Arrival:** On time to camp, report to Point of Contact upon arrival
- **Set Up:** Assisting the program area supervisor to set out all equipment and to prep the targets
- Assisting the program area supervisor in outfitting all participants and coordinating shooting lines
- Safety of all participants while at the range
- Contacting the Program Coordinator if the need arises
- **Clean Up:** neatly putting away all equipment and stripping all targets from the bales
