**Job Title:** Climbing Wall Volunteer

### Position Summary:

The Climbing Wall Program Volunteer position is available year round during both our summer program and family weekend programs. Volunteers who are interested in this position will go through a quick training to become Camp Korey approved belayers. The training will cover the mission of camp, policies and procedures, emergency response and best practices. Trainings will be given periodically throughout the year and refresher trainings will be required annually.

### Qualifications

- Prior training or experience required: experience with top rope belay, Camp Korey policies and procedures training renewed annually
- Recommended: friendly, approachable, organized, accountable
- Current background check on file
- Must be physically independent to perform the duties of the volunteer position without the routine assistance of the medical professionals on site
- Flu Vaccine required November 1 - April 1
- Age 19+

### Responsibilities

- **Arrival:** On time to camp, report to Point of Contact upon arrival
- **Set Up:** Climbing wall volunteers are responsible for the complete set-up of the program area including gear inspection, and pulling ropes
- Assisting camp participants, keeping participants safe, emergency response
- Contacting the Program Coordinator if the need arises
- **Clean Up:** Tearing down and storing all ropes and gear, rope inspection, recording daily use inspections in the inspections binder
