Position Summary: The Equestrian Program Volunteer position is available during our summer program. It is recommended that all volunteers have some experience with horses or equestrian programs. Volunteers will be working with our contract equestrian partner. In addition a Camp Korey staff member will also be assigned to assist the program as well. Qualifications

- Prior training or experience required: basic understanding of horse safety
- Recommended: experience working with an equestrian program
- Current background check on file
- Must be physically independent to perform the duties of the volunteer position without the routine assistance of the medical professionals on site
- Flu Vaccine required November 1 - April 1
- Age 19+

Responsibilities

- **Arrival:** On time to camp, report to the equestrian team on arrival
- **Set Up:** Make sure tents and camper receptions are set and ready. Check-in with the program leads about your comfort level around horses
- You will be assigned a sidewalk or lead walk position
- Ensure all participants have a safe and fun time while at equestrian. Assure that helmets are worn at all times while on horseback. Participants will get on and off the horses with step-up blocks and assistance
- Contact the Program Coordinator if the need arises
- **Clean Up:** Help pick up all helmets and gear
