



## CAMP KOREY VOLUNTEER JOB DESCRIPTION

**Job Title:** Family Weekend Driver  
**Department:** CAMPER OPERATIONS

**Residency:** Day Volunteer

### Position Summary:

During family weekends with known high mobility needs Camp Korey will offer one to two Family Weekend Driver positions. It is the responsibility of the drivers to coordinate pickups and drop offs of families to the program areas around camp. Drivers will be equipped with walkie talkies to help facilitate this. Drivers will be required to submit a copy of their driver's license to be filed with camp, go through vehicle-by-vehicle training and demonstrate safe driving practices before joining the roster of approved Camp Korey drivers. Trainings will be offered on an as-needed basis.

**Typical Hours:** Family Weekends, Saturday 9:30am-1:30pm or 2:30-9pm  
No more than 2 drivers at a time

### Qualifications

- Prior training or experience required: Training and approval in driving at least 2 different types of Camp Korey vehicles. Knowledge of the site
- Recommended: Good communicator, friendly, helpful, okay with downtime
- Copy of driver's license on file with volunteer program staff
- Current background check on file
- Must be physically independent to perform the duties of the volunteer position without the routine assistance of the medical professionals on site
- Flu Vaccine required November 1 - April 1
- Age 21+

### Responsibilities

- Coordinate with the Camp Leadership Team for all requested pickups and drop offs of families around camp to different program areas
- Alert camp staff about necessary vehicle maintenance or any incidents that may arise while driving around camp
- Know and adhere to all policies and procedures with regards to camp vehicles and transporting participants around camp
