**Job Title:** Fishing and Boating Volunteer  
**Department:** CAMPER OPERATIONS

**Residency:** Day Volunteer

### **Position Summary:**

The Fishing and Boating Program Volunteer position is available year around during both our summer program and family weekend programs. It is recommended that all volunteers have some experience with fishing and boating. There will always be a Camp Korey staff member assigned to fishing and boating as the program area supervisor and they would be happy to answer any questions and walk you through the program.

### **Qualifications**

- Prior training or experience required: basic understanding of water safety
- Recommended: Red Cross Small Craft Safety Certification, Red Cross Lifeguard, experience bait fishing, experience boating
- Current background check on file
- Must be physically independent to perform the duties of the volunteer position without the routine assistance of the medical professionals on site
- Flu Shot required November 1 - April 1
- Age 19+

### **Responsibilities**

- **Arrival:** On time to camp, report to Point of Contact upon arrival
- **Set Up:** Dry off all the boats, prep worms, tidy up life jackets
- Ensure all participants have a safe and fun time while at fishing and boating. Assure that life vests are worn at all times on the dock and near the shore, participants get in and out of boats safely, that all boats are tied up, and that all participants who choose to fish are well supplied with worms
- Help to coordinate bus trips to and from fishing and boating
- Contact the Program Coordinator if the need arises
- **Clean Up:** Rack all fishing poles, tidy up the life vests, and make sure all boats are tied down to the dock.
