



Skagit County First Responder Covid-19 Quarantine Use Agreement

Camp Korey agrees to provide housing in one of its lodges, municipally described as 24880 Brotherhood Road, Mount Vernon WA 98274 (the "Property"), for use as a temporary quarantine shelter for first responders to prevent the spread of Covid-19 in accordance with a memorandum of understanding between Skagit County and Camp Korey.

Quarantine Period:

1. The use of Camp Korey will be effective from _____ through _____. The period can be extended at the request of Skagit County.

Care and Use of the Property:

2. Other than the first responder sheltering on the property (the "First Responder") and the First Responder's immediate family members, no other persons will live in the Property without the prior written permission of Camp Korey.
3. The First Responder agrees and acknowledges that the Property has been designated as a smoke-free and nut-free living environment.
4. No pets or animals are allowed to be kept in or about the Property without the prior written permission of Camp Korey.
5. The First Responder will not make any noise or nuisance which, in the reasonable opinion of Camp Korey, disturbs the comfort or convenience of other tenants and staff.
6. The First Responder will keep the Property reasonably clean and will dispose of trash in approved containers.
7. Camp Korey and the First Responder will comply with standards of health, sanitation, fire, housing and safety as required by law.

Rules and Regulations:

8. The First Responder will obey all rules and regulations of Camp Korey regarding the property.

General Provisions:

9. The First Responder is responsible for all damage to the Property arising from the activities of the First Responder or any person for whom the First Responder is responsible.
10. The First Responder agrees that Camp Korey will not be held liable or responsible in any way for any injury or death that maybe suffered or sustained by the First Responder or by any person for whom the First Responder is responsible. The First Responder is not relying on Camp Korey for any healthcare, quarantine, or safety-related services. Further, the First Responder assumes full responsibility for their own safety on the Property, and that of any person for whom the First Responder is responsible.
11. The First Responder gives permission to Camp Korey and Camp Korey authorized news media to photograph and to use pictures, video, or audio tapes of their person either alone or in groups for the newsletter, advertising purposes, fund-raising activities, bulletin boards, camp albums or in promoting public understanding and support for children with chronic medical conditions or serious illnesses or substantially similar purposes.
12. First Responders will not record (video, audio, photography) minors or campers while on premises.
