



## CAMP KOREY VOLUNTEER ROLE DESCRIPTION

**Job Title:** Staff Support – Food and/or Supply Delivery

**Department:** Programs

### **Position Summary:**

Thank you for your interest in volunteering at Camp Korey! Our Support Staff Volunteers are a new role in the summer of 2021! You will play a vital role in the overall success of programming at Camp Korey by creating intentional opportunities to support and enrich our seasonal staff. Residential camp programming in 2021 will offer a Family Centered Model for all in-person programs. For the safety of our campers, the Camp Korey seasonal staff will quarantine for the entire summer. We are committing to provide both physical and emotional support for our seasonal staff throughout the summer as they are committing to the physical and emotional support of our campers.

- **Food Delivery:** Seasonal staff will not be allowed to explore and experience the local culture of Skagit County and beyond so this role will function as “uber eats” for Camp Korey seasonal staff. Be willing to coordinate ordering, pick-up and delivery of a meal from a local restaurant for all camp staff during their weekend time off. (You would not be required to cover the food cost)
- **Supplies Delivery:** Seasonal staff will not be allowed to head off to the store for their treats and supplies needed to make it through the week. This role will coordinate with our Staff Support Coordinator to be the “Click List” shopper for our seasonal staff. (You will not be required to cover costs of these supplies.)

### **Qualifications:**

- Adhere to all CDC guidelines and protocols. Masks must be worn at all times around our staff.
